

How Do I Study ICB Level II Certificate in Small Business Financial Control

This course is a home study course which will allow you study when it is convenient to you.

How does it work?

When you enrol onto your course you will receive a log in details for our online course. Each of the three modules is assessed and marked by Mycourse Training – a selection of your assessments will be sent to the ICB for moderation.

What will my tutor do?

If you are already registered as a student or member of the ICB you will not need to register, otherwise there is a registration fee of £45 to be paid. This is included in the price of the course.
